THE PARABLES OF LENT SERIES:

Welcome to a special Ash Wednesday service in the Parables of Lent series, based on the parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector. In this parable, the tax collector who repents goes home justified, while the proud Pharisee does not. The parable reminds us that we, too, who repent are justified through Christ. The service includes an Imposition of Ashes, readings from Scripture, a children's sermon, a sermon and thematic hymns that help us to remember that we receive justification only in Christ.
