FROM: Ruth Mageria, Executive Director of CROS regarding the food pantries.

"Despite talk of the economy improving, the seven food pantries of CROS have been kept busy. The two most frequented food pantries are Lake Worth and Riviera Beach. These two pantries continue to be very busy distributing food to close to 2,000 individuals per month.

In 2014 CROS reached a new milestone of having distributed food to 63,166 individuals, representing 22,302 families, 40% of whom were children."
